What is FUSE?

FUSE is a technology marketplace and community operated by YOT LTD in Malta. Discover equipment, organise useful product collections and learn from people with first-hand experience.

Choose what you want to do

1

Find the right equipment

Search the marketplace, compare products and check the current price, availability and delivery options.

2

Build your own store

Enable Igniter, create a collection and add FUSE catalogue products or equipment you own. Listings and stores go through review.

3

Share useful experience

Choose a published mission and create an original review, video or guide. Approved work can earn the reward stated in that brief.

Your FUSE platform account and Igniter membership are free. Optional paid trade plans are separate. A store visit, upload or completed lesson does not automatically create an earning.

JOIN IGNITER

One account. One clear start.

Create your account, then enable the tools you want to use.

1

Start your Igniter journey

Open the Igniter page and choose Start your Igniter journey. If you already have an account, sign in instead.

2

Create your free FUSE account

Enter your full name, email and password, or continue with Google. The Igniter signup route keeps your destination as you move through the account steps.

3

Verify your email

For email signup, enter the six-digit verification code. You return to the Igniter journey after verification.

4

Enable Igniter

Choose Become an Igniter, enter your public display name and a unique handle, then read and accept the programme rules.

5

Choose your first focus

My Igniter shows that your account is Igniter enabled. Choose Sell products or Contribute & earn rewards to see your next step.

Your public handle uses 3–30 lowercase letters, numbers, underscores or hyphens. Start with a letter or number. Choose carefully: the current workspace does not offer handle changes.

YOUR FIRST STORE

Start with one useful collection.

You do not need a full catalogue to begin.

1

Create your store profile

When selling is available, open Your store in the Igniter menu. Give your store a name, a short introduction and your areas of experience. Complete the reply hours, time zone and seller details requested by the form.

2

Add a collection

Choose a real need: for example, a small home office. Give the collection a clear name and add products that solve that need.

3

Choose a listing type

FUSE catalogue: find and add an existing product. Own equipment: enter its title, description, condition, quantity, asking price and collection or delivery arrangements.

Before you submit equipment

Detail	Make it useful
Condition	Describe wear, missing parts and faults honestly.
Photo	Use a clear JPG, PNG or WebP under 3 MB.
Price and quantity	Use the asking price and the quantity you can actually supply.
Delivery	Describe your preference. A reviewed delivery quote is a separate step.

Save your draft, submit the listing, then submit the store when eligible. Follow review feedback in your workspace. Publication is not automatic; editing a published store can require another review.

CONTRIBUTE & EARN

Share evidence people can use.

A review, video or guide starts with an appropriate published mission.

1

Choose a mission

Read its brief, reward, deadline and available places. Choose something that matches your real experience.

2

Create original work

For a review, explain first-hand use, strengths and limitations. For a video, use your original public YouTube or Vimeo link and useful timestamps. For a guide, explain repeatable steps or a compatible shortlist.

3

Submit the evidence

Open the mission and complete its contribution form. Use a working HTTPS evidence link where requested. Explain what you tested and disclose any commercial or reward relationship.

4

Follow the review

Pending work has not earned its reward yet. If changes are requested, read the feedback and improve the original submission. Approved work receives the reward specified by that mission.

Honest negative reviews are welcome. A positive rating, repeated upload, copied work or a lesson completion is not a shortcut to HP, shopping credit or money.

POINTS, LEVELS & REWARDS

Three balances. Different jobs.

Look at both the reward type and whether it is available.

Helpful Points build your reputation

HP recognise approved contributions and determine your Igniter level. They have no cash value and cannot be spent or converted into shopping points.

Spark	Pro	Max	Ultra	Blaze
0 HP	500 HP	1,500 HP	3,500 HP	7,000 HP

Shopping points provide eligible credit

100 shopping points equal €1 of FUSE credit when redemption is available. Earn them only through an offer that explicitly includes shopping points. Checkout shows how much your basket can use.

Example: 500 shopping points have a €5 conversion value. If a sample €30 basket can use that full credit, €25 remains to pay. Actual eligibility and limits are shown at checkout.

Cash follows a funded offer

A mission must explicitly offer cash. Pending rewards still need the required review or clearing checks. Only an available balance and an eligible account can move into the withdrawal process shown in the wallet.

HP-only missions do not become cash rewards when your level increases. Seller payments are separate from mission rewards.

COSTS OF OPERATING

Know the offer before you sell.

Your FUSE platform account stays free. Review costs before accepting a sale.

Current equipment arrangements

The supported equipment resale flow uses an approved arrangement in which FUSE buys equipment from the Igniter and sells it to the customer. Review your agreed equipment amount, delivery responsibility and payment details before accepting the offer. Catalogue recommendations do not currently create automatic referral commission.

Planned seller pricing – not yet active

Item	Planned charge
FUSE platform account	Free
Status-based sales commission	Spark: 15% · Pro: 12% · Max: 9% · Ultra: 6% · Blaze: 3% Commission decreases by 3 percentage points per tier.
Bank transfer	0.5%
Card payment	Stripe processing cost + 0.5%
Introductory offer	Three months without sales commission. Start dates, eligibility and treatment of processing costs will be published before activation.

Cost-plus illustration: sell for €120 against a €100 B2B cost. Deduct commission on the €120 selling price, then the €100 cost. Earnings: Spark €2.00; Pro €5.60; Max €9.20; Ultra €12.80; Blaze €16.40. This excludes processing charges and uses a consistent VAT basis. It does not activate seller markups.

These planned terms are not a live charge or a current trial entitlement. Use the terms and amounts displayed before accepting a real offer. Optional paid business plans are separate from free Igniter membership.

SELLING, DELIVERY & PAYMENT

A listing is the beginning.

Keep the customer, delivery and payment steps connected.

1

Review the sale arrangement

Check who the legal seller is, the agreed equipment amount, costs and who is responsible for dispatch. A listing preference does not book delivery.

2

Accept a reviewed quote

Collection and delivery use approved arrangements. Check the destination, delivery charge and amount you receive before checkout becomes available.

3

Wait for confirmed payment

An enquiry is not a paid order. Use the order status shown in your workspace instead of a message or screenshot as confirmation.

4

Record the real handover or dispatch

The assigned dispatcher records the actual shipment, tracking or collection details. A dispatch email is a task notification, not proof of shipment.

5

Follow receipt and settlement

Customer receipt, verification, any holds and the accepted arrangement determine when settlement can proceed. Payment or dispatch alone does not make a payout available.

For returns, disputes or an arrangement not offered in your account, contact FUSE with the order reference. Do not promise unsupported delivery or payment terms in chat.
